WALKING WEEKEND TO KERRY - EASTER 1993

The organised walks will be targeted at **experienced moderate and hard walkers**. Participants will be expected to walk at a **moderate** pace for about **6 hours/12 miles** duration over mainly trackless terrain. The trip is particularly suitable for experienced walkers based in Limerick or Cork.

Walks planned to include:

- Ridge of the Reeks,
- Mangerton and the Devils Punchbowl,
- Brandon ridge,
- Purple and Toomies ridge,
- Paps.

The walks planned include all the Irish Munroes excluding Galtymore and Lugnaquilla. These walks are subject to suitable weather conditions. Alternative low level walks along the Kerry Way will be organised should weather conditions make it unsafe to do the proposed high level walks.

What to bring:

- An Oige membership card,
- Walking boots (no wellingtons/runners allowed),
- Change of clothes and hiking socks,
- Waterproof jacket and overtrousers,
- Warm clothing (no jeans on the hills),
- Gloves and balaclava/woolen hat,
- Suntan lotion/nivea,
- Flask, teabags/coffee and dried milk,
- Sheet sleeping bag.

Cost:

There will be two costs depending upon whether or not you wish to be supplied with meals in Killarney.

Cost (excluding meals)

£55

This includes all transport from Dublin to Killarney return as well as to the start of and collection from the end of the walks each day. It also includes **five overnights** at Killarney International Hostel (Aghadoe House).

Cost (including meals & packed lunches)

£105

This includes all transport from Dublin to Killarney return as well as to the start of and collection from the end of the walks each day. It also includes **five overnights** as well as full Irish breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal each day at Killarney International Hostel (Aghadoe House).

Booking

£30 non refundable booking deposit. Balance to be paid to An Oige head office **no later than Thursday, 1st April 1993.** Payment may be made by credit card. Please indicate at time of booking whether you require meals or not. Also, if taking meals, whether you require vegetarian/standard.
